
Mrs Blagg/Mrs Howland Curriculum Review Autumn 2023

English

This term we have read the books, 'The Tin Forest' and 'Stone Age Boy'. The children have written a range of text types including descriptive writing, stories, instructions and letters. They have tried hard to include a variety of punctuation and to structure their sentences correctly.





Music

Geography
