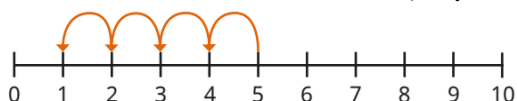
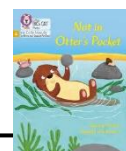


# Y1/2WC Curriculum Review

## Maths

This term we have moved on to understanding numbers to 20. We have learned how many tens and ones each teen number has and we can represent the numbers using a variety of equipment. We are beginning to remember addition facts to make numbers within 10 and are getting better at writing a fact family. Using a number line has been a little tricky for us this term but we are getting better each day!



## Phonics

Throughout the term, we have continued to learn both new graphemes and new phonemes. We are good detectives now and can usually spy the correct phonemes even with their alternative pronunciations! We have also worked hard with our consonant clusters at both the start and the end of a word. When we are reading, we are able to sound talk the words in our head and can read them fluently out loud. Sometimes we can even read them automatically with no sound talking.
