# Spring 2024



### English

In English this term. Year 2 enjoyed reading and studying 'The Bear and the Piano' by David Litchfield and were taken on an imaginative journey with the bear from the forest to the big, bright city. The children have been expanding their sentences with use of adjectives, adverbs and a range of conjunctions. The quality of their work has improved greatly. We have also studied the story 'House held up by Trees' which has motivated the children to think about trees and how we can be considerate about the world we live in. On World Book Day, the children enjoyed the series of books by the author and illustrator Benji Davies.

### Maths

Recently, we have improved our knowledge of fractions, 2-D and 3-D shapes.
