School Site Reminders



Please could parents follow our one-way system when collecting pupils from school. Parents need to come in via the main entrance to access the yard and then leave via the Key Stage 2 gate. This ensures that home time runs as smoothly and as safely as possible for everyone.

A reminder that we are encouraging all children to arrive to school promptly as we do not want children to miss out on

their learning. The KS2 gate (near to the main entrance of the car park) closes at

8.50am as staff need to return to class to focus on teaching and learning. The Reception and KS1 gate will also close at 8.50am to enable staff to return to class. Once this gate is closed anyone arriving after 8.50am will need to use the main school entrance gate and sign in at reception.

Pupil Attendance

We need to safeguard all pupils in school so when a pupil is absent, and we have not heard from the pupil's family for 3 days then we will call out to the home to check that the pupil is fit and well. If we are not able to make contact, then we may refer this to the local authority safeguarding team. If you are on holiday, then please let the school know so that it does not become a safeguarding issue.

Uniform

Thank you also for your support with ensuring our pupils attend school in the correct uniform. If anyone needs any additional uniform, then please let the school office know as we have lots of spare second-hand jumpers.

<u>School Meal Prices – Year 3 and above</u>



The Local Authority increased the price of school meals some time ago. We have subsidised this price increase so that parents will pay £2.75 per meal. This reflects the rising costs in food. This charge applies to all pupils in Year 3 and above who are not in receipt of free school meals. If your circumstances have changed and you think you are entitled to free school

meals, then please contact the school office to collect a form.

PE Kit

Children in Year 2 to Year 6 can come to school dressed in their PE kits on their specified PE days.

Children in Reception and Year 1 will continue to change into their PE kits at school. Please bring kits in a school drawstring bag.

OPAL (Outdoor Play and Learning)

Miss True introduced our new playtime project this week in assembly. The project is called OPAL (Outdoor Play and Learning) and it will take approximately 18 months to complete. By working with the OPAL Team, we hope to improve our pupil's playtime experiences. Over the next few weeks, we will be introducing small changes to playtimes. Pupils will be informed regularly of any changes and are actively encouraged to discuss the changes that will happen with the OPAL Play team, which is led by Miss True.



Water bottles

This is a reminder that children are encouraged to bring a water bottle into school to have in class. It is important that children stay hydrated throughout the day, especially in warm weather which hopefully is not over yet! This must be water and not juice. We don't bring large water bottles into school as we don't have space.

Grapes
