On Thursday 19th February, there will be a Valentines Disco for the children to attend. Mrs Smith (Rec), Mrs Coad (Rec), Miss Bujara (Year 1), Miss Heslop (Year 2) and Mrs Irwin (Year 1/2) pupils will attend from 3.30pm – 4.45pm. Reception pupils to come to school in disco clothes as they will be having a friendship themed day.

Miss Trainer (Year 3), Mrs Blagg/Mrs Howland (Year 3/4), Miss True (Year 4), Miss Jamieson (Year 6), Mrs Walker (Year 5/6) and Mrs Murray (Year 5) pupils will attend from 5.00pm until 6.15pm. Tickets will be £2 and will include a cake and a drink. This needs to be paid online via ParentPay. Children can bring money to buy sweets from our sweet shop (please put this in an envelope with their name on). The funds raised from this event will go towards subsidising our planned end of year beach trip.

We will be celebrating World Book Day across school and we are inviting children to come to school dressed as their favourite book character or in their pyjamas ready for a cosy story time in class.

Birthday Celebrations



A reminder that parents can make a payment of £2 via Parent Pay if they wish to have their photo taken with 2 friends next to the birthday flag. They will need to let the school office know in advance so that we can arrange to have the flag raised. Children can bring sweets in for their class if they wish to on their birthday. These must be in sealed packets that can be sent home with the child (e.g. mini rolls, haribos, fun size chocolates).

The children are really concerned about the traffic and pollution around the school site at drop off and collection times. After school childcare will run from 3.15pm until 6pm with a view to also providing an earlier childcare breakfast club offer if we have sufficient need. Pupil Attendance

As we are now part of Northern Lights Learning Trust, we will be working towards following their guidance for attendance. We will update you in due course on how these changes will affect you.

We need to safeguard all pupils in school so when a pupil is absent, and we have not heard from the pupil's family for 3 days then we will call out to the home to check that the pupil is fit and well. If we are not able to make contact, then we may refer this to the local authority safeguarding team. If you are on holiday, then please let the school know so that it does not become a safeguarding issue.
